Macon County Health Department to Hold H1N1 Vaccination Clinic in Mt. Zion

DECATUR, IL – The Macon County Health Department will be offering free H1N1 vaccinations on Tuesday, November 3, 2009, from 4 to 7 p.m. at the Mt. Zion Intermediate School at 310 South Henderson Street in Mt. Zion. This clinic will serve those within the following priority groups on a walk-in, first come, first-served basis. The priority groups that will be able to receive a vaccination on Tuesday, November 3 include:

- Pregnant women,
- Household contacts and caregivers for children under 6 months of age,
- Healthcare and emergency medical services personnel,
- People ages 3 through 24, and
- People ages 25 through 64 with a chronic health condition.

The Macon County Health Department has and will continue to follow the Advisory Committee on Immunization Practices (**ACIP**) guidelines when deciding who will receive the H1N1 vaccine. Those who are not within the high-risk priority groups will be turned away.
