Managing medications can be frustrating and confusing. We are here to help! The Macon County Health Department offers Medication Management performed by a Registered Nurse and is available for clients of all ages.



Services Include:

- Medication set up for client as determined appropriate by RN and physician
- Home visits for medication changes
- Chronic disease and medication education
- Blood pressure checks
- Blood glucose checks
- Pre-fill insulin syringes
- Order refills
- 90 day medication list update from physicians
- Vitamin B12 injections
- Coordinated care with physicians and health services

Success Stories

“Medication Management saved my life...”

At an initial visit for a new client, the Medication Management nurse discovered that the client was taking two of the same heart medications. The medications had two different names, were prescribed by two different doctors, and were filled by two different pharmacies. They were potent heart medications and taking both of them could have been potentially fatal for the client.

“Medication Management discovered the pharmacy gave me someone else’s prescription...”

After arriving at a client’s home to set up medications, the Medication Management nurse was informed that the client had a new medication. After speaking with the client, the nurse determined that she had not recently been to the doctor or been diagnosed with any new conditions. The nurse made a call to the pharmacy and it was determined that they had given the patient someone else’s medication. Without the Medication Management monitoring, this client would have taken a medication that could have been potentially dangerous to her, as it was prescribed for someone else.
