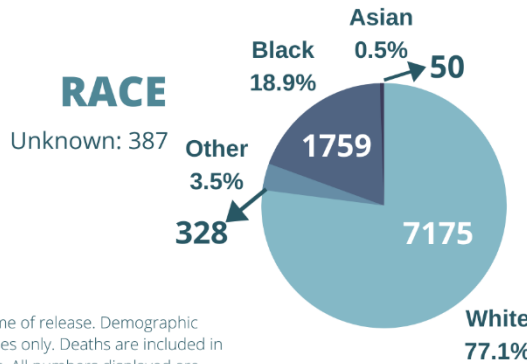
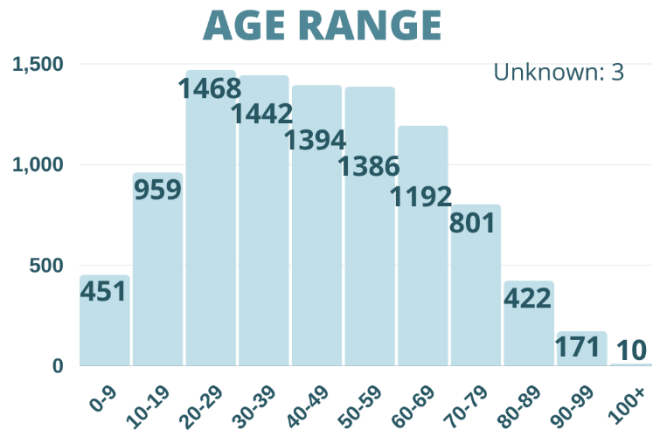
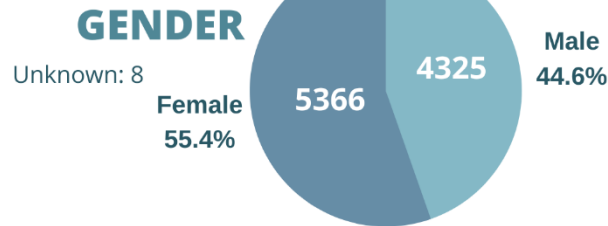

Please note that, while we reported 40 new cases yesterday (a combination of Saturday, Sunday and Monday's numbers) and 10 new cases today, through case investigations it was determined that two cases were found to be residents of other counties and have been transferred to the appropriate health departments. Therefore, the total of number of cases since the beginning of the pandemic is 9,699.
