The Better Birth Outcomes program is available to high-risk pregnant women in Macon County.

Risk factors which may qualify you for the program include:

- Diseases that affect pregnancy
- Homelessness
- Under age 15 or over age 40
- Pregnant with twins or more
- Previous pre-term delivery
- BMI equal to or greater than 30
- Previously incarcerated or under house arrest
- Weight less than 100 pounds
- Previously or currently has a child in DCFS custody
- Victim of domestic violence
- Over 18 and less than a 10th grade education
- Alcohol, tobacco, or other substance abuse during pregnancy
- Many other risk factors...
