**Macon County Vaccination Update**

DECATUR, IL – Due to severe inclement winter weather, the Macon County Health Department (MCHD) has seen a delay in the shipment of vaccines all week that will continue into next week. As soon as the MCHD receives confirmation of shipment, our staff will contact those who are due for their 2<sup>nd</sup> dose next week who have not been able to make an appointment. This will include those who received their 1<sup>st</sup> dose on January 26<sup>th</sup> and January 28<sup>th</sup>. We apologize for any inconvenience, but we do not have control over these shipments.

Due to the significant decrease in Macon County's COVID-19 vaccine allocation and weather delays, we have not had vaccine available for 1<sup>st</sup> doses this week and will not have any 1<sup>st</sup> dose clinics next week.
