**Illinois National Guard Planning To Administer Up To 600 Johnson & Johnson COVID-19 Vaccine Doses in Macon County**

DECATUR, IL - On Friday, May 7<sup>th</sup>, the Illinois National Guard is planning to bring 600 doses of the Johnson & Johnson COVID-19 vaccine to be administered at the Macon County Health Department. Please note the details of this specific clinic in their entirety below:

- Date: Friday, May 7, 2021
- Time: 9:00 a.m. to 6:00 p.m.
- Location: Macon County Health Department, 1221 E. Condit Street in Decatur
- \*\*\*For this specific clinic **ONLY**, any Illinois resident may make an appointment to be vaccinated.\*\*\*
- Persons who wish to receive this single-dose vaccine should be 18 years of age or older and should NOT have previously received a COVID-19 vaccine dose of any kind.

**Eligible persons can walk-in or visit <https://events.juware.com/IL-IDPH/3659d9e4-bdbc-4783-85ec-5cb7fed7757a/> to schedule an appointment.** Before arriving to the clinic, please take your temperature and screen yourself for COVID-19 symptoms. If you have a temperature greater than 100.4 degrees, are experiencing any symptoms or signs of illness, are awaiting a COVID-19 test result or have been identified as a close contact of a positive COVID-19 case, do not attend the clinic. Please wear a face covering. Please bring a photo ID to verify age eligibility and your current insurance card or red, white and blue Medicare card.
